Get Together to Meet Fellow Democrats

Call our U.S. Senators today.

The **SAVE America Act** and the **Make Elections Great Again Act**, require voters to present documentary proof of citizenship to 1) register to vote and to 2) vote at the polls.

It is already illegal for noncitizens to register and vote in federal or state elections. Requiring documentary proof of American citizenship to register and vote in federal elections is unnecessary and simply creates another barrier to voting.

This has already passed the House and will be voted on in the US Senate either this week or next. **Call our U.S. Senators today.**

For the Presidential election last year, [5,751 Flagler Democrat women received a mail ballot](#). Ballots were all cancelled in December, so you needed to re-enroll. [To date, only 3,489 Flagler Democrat women have re-enrolled](#) (difference of 2,262).

Ladies, please set the example! If you haven't already, [sign yourselves up for a mail ballot online now](#). Or call the Supervisor of Elections at (386) 313-4170. Then encourage your family and friends to do the same.

Mail ballots offer several advantages, even if you don't use it for your vote. Receiving it is a reminder of an upcoming election, and it allows you the time to research the candidates before you do vote.

If ever this was a year to get those mail ballots early, at home, this is it.

I will provide an update on vote by mail numbers in mid-June when the next report is available. Let's rock this!
