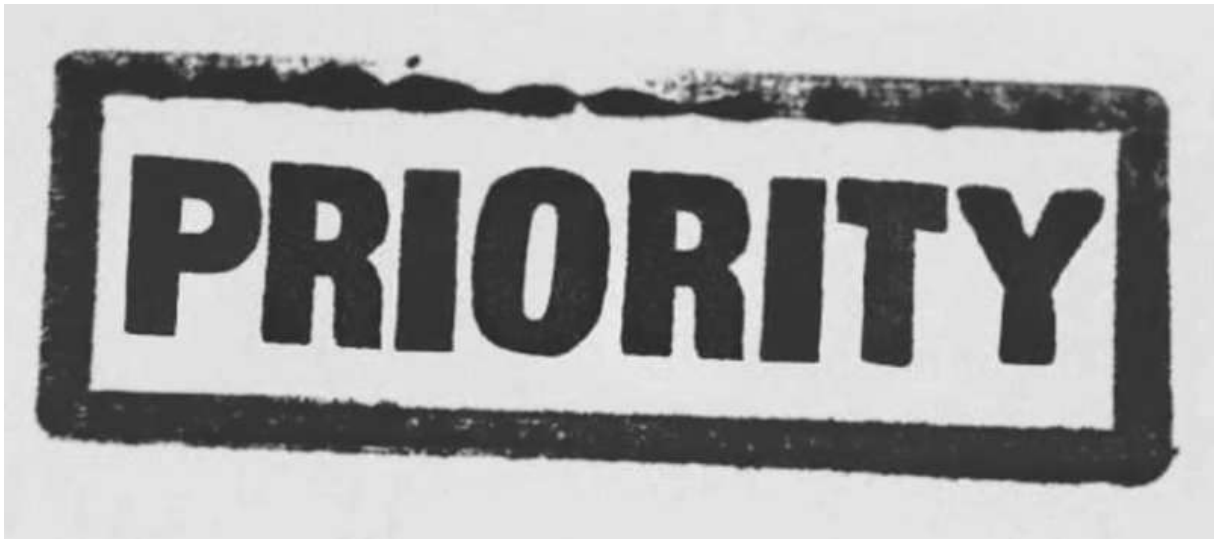
Hello, friends! I'm in central Illinois for a family situation. The skies just opened up for a crazy midwest storm. I miss those.

As this is a non-partisan seat, I have reached out through newsletters, emails and phone calls to thousands of Democrats and NPAs who live in SB District 2. I have not been successful in finding a candidate. Please help me find a level-headed candidate to run for school board against the incumbent, Will Furry.

According to public campaign finance reporting, Mr. Furry has received only **one** donation (\$50) above and beyond what he personally loaned his campaign. He is obviously not supported by the voters, and he has not been endorsed by the local and state officials who supported him in 2022.

Even if no one wants him, if he is unopposed, he will be re-elected. We can not let this happen.
