This amendment increases the homestead exemption, thus reducing property taxes for property owners. Most counties depend on this property tax to fund police, fire, EMS and other essential services. Counties could be forced to cut services for all, or make up the revenue shortfall through higher fees or other types of taxes which can fall heavily on renters and lower-income families.
